2007 SCCA Texas Region Solo Contingency Program

Official Rules

- Subaru of Dallas is an official contingency sponsor for the 2007 SCCA Texas Region Solo Series.
- Event Payouts: \$50.00 to each first place finisher in an eligible class.
- Championship Payouts: \$150 to each first place finisher in an eligible class at the SCCA Texas Region Solo Championship. There will also be a \$150 payout to the fastest pax time of the day, set by a Subaru.
- All participants must be registered before the start of their heat to be eligible for awards that day.
- Registration forms will be available through the SCCA Texas Region website or at the event from the Subaru of Dallas tent.
- Registrations must be renewed each year to be eligible for awards.
- Entrants must compete in a Subaru vehicle to be eligible for awards.
- Eligible Subaru vehicles can be of any year or model as long as they conform to the rules and regulations in the SCCA 2007 Solo Rulebook.
- All participating vehicles must display the approved Subaru of Dallas decal in order to be eligible for awards.
- The decal can be placed anywhere of the competitor's choosing on the front or rear of the vehicle, so long as it is plainly visible from either the front or the back.
- Decals can be picked up at Subaru of Dallas, 5403 Lemmon Avenue, Dallas, Texas, 75209. A limited number will be available at the event.
- The eligible classes for contingency payout are: AS, DS, GS, HS, STS, STU, STX, BSP, ESP, FSP, SM, NOVICE, STXL, and STUL.
- Cash awards will be paid at the event's awards ceremony. Monies will not be distributed before the trophies are given, unless notable reasons require an exception. This will be at the discretion of the event coordinators. If you can not stay to receive your award at the end of the event, please let the Subaru of Dallas representatives know.
- All awards must be signed for, by award recipient. Awards can not be accepted on behalf of another competitor.
- There must be a minimum of two (2) competitors in a class for that class to be eligible for award payouts.
- All winners are determined by SCCA Texas Region Rules and Regulations. Drivers must be eligible for Solo points to be eligible to receive awards. To be eligible for the Championship award, drivers must compete in five (5) of nine (9) eligible events.
- Subaru of Dallas or David Thomas Auto Group, and its subsidiaries are not responsible for any damage or loss due to competing in any SCCA event or by participating in this program. Participant assumes all risk and responsibility.
